



SAFETY REGULATIONS PACKAGING INNOVATIONS 2021

In order to ensure the safety to the participants in PACKAGING INNOVATIONS 2021, all most recent guidelines of the Ministry of Development, Ministry of Health and the Chief Sanitary Inspector shall apply to the fair site of EXPO XXI WARSZAWA, in particular:

1. In order to reduce direct contacts, it is recommended to comply with all the required formalities related to the attendance as exhibitor (e.g. registration of all employees who will attend the fact will facilitate the issue of personal IDs). Please send a valid list of employees delegated to the fair by **03.09.2021** to: gadarowska@targi.krakow.pl.
2. Free registration of visitors is required in the on-line system ([link here](#)). After registration, visitors will be provided with a free entry ticket valid for 2 days.
3. Each person entering the site of EXPO XXI WARSZAWA will be subject to contactless body temperature control and mandatory hand disinfection.
4. Inside the premises of EXPO XXI WARSZAWA it is absolutely required to cover nose and month (with a face mask, a face shield or another material).
5. Participants are obliged to keep a distance of minimum 1.5 m from other people. Thus, as far as possible, when staying on the fairgrounds all participants should hold a social distance of 1.5 m.
6. Before any commercial activity is taken, it is necessary to put on disposable gloves or disinfect hands. To this end, we have prepared for you a SAFETY PACKAGE which inter alia includes disposable face masks, gloves and a disinfectant, etc. Details of the package: <https://packaginginnovations.pl/gb/exhibiting/security-package.html>
7. The exhibitors are required to disinfect the common parts of their stands (counter tops, tables, cabinets, etc.) minimum very hour as well to disinfect the cashier's position and the service position.
8. Exhibitors may allow employees to work after body temperature control subject to their consent and provided with face masks / face shields and gloves if still required by the applicable laws. The event may not be attended by persons with symptoms of an infectious disease, those who have had contact with persons with clear disease symptoms or who were exposed to contact with an infected person less than 14 days before the PACKAGING INNOVATIONS fair. Exhibitors will be required to document epidemiological interviews held with their entire staff and to store the relevant details for two weeks so that they can be provided to competent bodies, e.g. to the competent Sanitary Inspector.
9. Employees/persons providing services at stands for Exhibitors who may have been exposed to SARS-CoV-2 infection outside the site shall immediately report the condition to the employer/principal and notify the



epidemiological station; until an examination and decision, such persons shall refrain from participating in the fair.

10. Exhibitors shall train their personnel servicing the stands on the sanitary regime and safety when at the fair stand.

11. Exhibitors shall ensure personal protective means at the stand for their personnel (face masks, face shields, gloves) and disinfectants as long as those provided in the package prove insufficient.

12. Exhibitors shall provide an adequate number of containers with disinfectants in visible locations at their stands.

13. Exhibitors shall keep an appropriate distance from the persons entering their stands and avoid shaking hands.

14. The number of available seats at the stand should be planned so that a distance of minimum 1.5 m is kept unless the existing safety rules not change.

15. All shows with the exhibited equipment are permitted subject to compliance with the recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspection. Show organizers are obliged to monitor the number of people attending the presentation. Therefore, time restrictions will apply to availability of stand space for visitors. After a completed presentation, the Organizer shall disinfect the equipment touched by visitors.

16. Distribution of advertising materials outside the stand is prohibited. It is recommended that advertising materials are made available from the level of racks/counters. The persons distributing materials (by the Exhibitor's stand) shall wear gloves, face masks/face shield and be provided with a disinfectant for regular hand disinfection.

18. Storage of waste in closed containers, regularly cleaned and disinfected.

19. Drinks and snacks should be prepared in compliance with the safety rules applicable to catering facilities.

20. The fair Organizer shall be obliged to monitor the number of people inside the premises used by participants in compliance with guidelines relating to the type and use of the premises. Therefore, there may be restrictions with access to certain premises (e.g. toilets, conference rooms, restaurant, etc.)

21. Absolutely no persons who are undergoing quarantine, isolation or epidemiological supervision will be allowed to the EXPO XXI WARSZAWA site.

22. Each fair participant when at the EXPO XXI WARSZAWA site - in case they feel unwell - shall immediately report to the designated medical point or inform the Sanitary Safety Inspector thereof at telephone number +48 513 448 494.
